

Marriage at Plymouth

"At Plymouth Church, we believe that marriage is a sacred opportunity for people to practice Christian discipleship by making a public commitment to a lifetime of love and faithfulness, and to do so within the context of a worshipping community. As an Open and Affirming congregation, Plymouth Church will perform wedding ceremonies for any of its members, regardless of affectional orientation. Our wedding policy for same and opposite-sex couples is identical. In all instances, those desiring a wedding in the church are required to be members of the church, or children of members, and couples are asked to engage in a course of pre-marital counseling with the minister performing the ceremony.
